Registration Info

The workshop is open to adults who have completed a canine freestyle class (or equivalent). There are two ways to participate: (1) as a *working team*, defined as one handler and one dog; or (2) as an *auditor/observer* (no dog). Only those who are registered for the workshop may attend. No guests, please.

Please provide proof of your dog's vaccination status (distemper, parvo, rabies) with your registration. Vaccinations must be current *at the time of the workshop*, so be prepared to show updated records, as necessary. The facility will not admit dogs who do not have proof of current vaccination status.

Payment in full is required with your registration to hold your place at the workshop. Dog rules and etiquette

- Dogs must be quiet, under control, and leashed or crated at all times. Do not bring multiple dogs. Only dogs who are registered for the workshop will be admitted to the facility.
- Bring a crate to confine your dog during those portions of the seminar when s/he will not be working. Due to space limitations, we cannot accommodate exercise pens. If you have a wire crate, please bring a pad to place under it in order to protect the floor.
- Dogs will be working in close proximity to other dogs and people for two long days. Will your dog be comfortable and safe in this environment? Any dog who is disruptive or who behaves in an aggressive manner, as determined by event staff, will be requested to leave. If your dog is excused from the workshop, you will not receive a refund.

Food and beverages

You may purchase a box lunch for one or both days. See the registration form for ordering information. If you prefer, you are free to go out on your own for lunch. Fast food restaurants are a short drive from the facility. You may also choose to bring your lunch. Beverages will be provided.
